Just some of the great things we have supported so far...



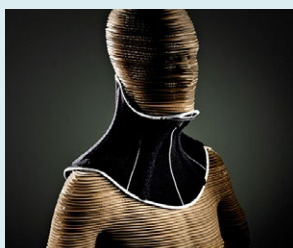
This remarkable hospice has been providing invaluable, palliative care & support for people living with a life-limiting illness and those dealing with bereavement across the North Somerset region for over 30 years. It is particularly close to Malcolm's family's hearts and we have therefore been a big supporter of their magnificent work which is almost entirely dependent on charitable donations.



Losing the ability to speak and communicate properly is a devastating stage of MND so we are proud to say that we have been able to provide some fantastic, specialist speech text equipment that allows patients to record their own voices and enable them to communicate with carers, family and friends.



Of course, it's not just individuals who are affected by MND. The local MNDa branches have set up Quality of Life Grant (QLG) aid programmes to also provide assistance to family and carers whilst looking after their loved ones. Just simple things like transport costs, household maintenance, short breaks and respite care can have a huge impact in helping all those affected during an intense period of illness. We have therefore made a significant commitment to enter into a partnership with the Bristol & Bath MND Association to underwrite their QLG's for the next three years.



Malcolm latterly struggled with posture and head support which was most problematic when eating & drinking. We have therefore invested in a number of specialist neck collars to provide some comfort for MND sufferers in this region.

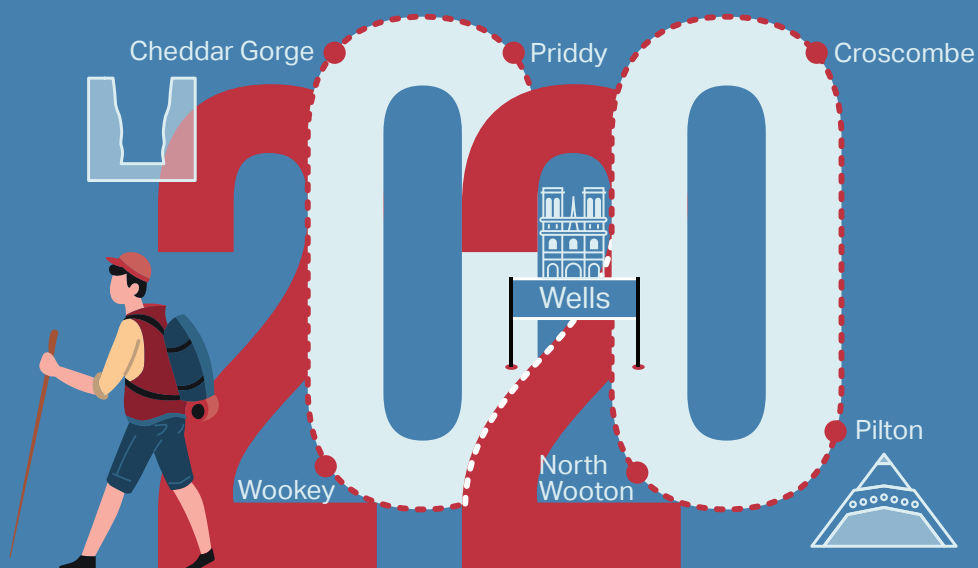
